Safety....simple approach

- "Fail to plan, plan to fail"
- Fail to plan for safety, plan to fail your program and getting to a safe, productive and prevention focussed workplace.
- If we plan for investigations, we do not need to investigate events!





CONTEXT – CASE FOR INVESTIGATIONS in 2022 – Previous Year

Daily workplace injury and loss statistics:

- ILO: 6,000 deaths each day, 340 million accidents and 160 million victims of workrelated illnesses annually
- US 4,764 workplace fatalities in US (2020)
- 925 in Canada and rising around the world.





CONTEXT – CASE FOR INVESTIGATIONS 2023 Conference

Daily workplace injury and loss statistics:

- ILO: 6,000 deaths each day, 340 million accidents and 160 million victims of workrelated illnesses annually
- US 5,190 workplace fatalities in US (8%+)
- 1,081 in Canada workplace fatalitites. (16%+)



CONTEXT – My Story

- Updated ASSP 3rd edition, Accident Investigation Techniques
- Chair of the CSA Incident Investigation Standard CZA Z1005-2021, 3 decades and thousands of incident investigation reviews at the Workplace Safety & Insurance Board
- "Many investigate workplace incidents not aligned to a recognized investigation standard and it is a recipe for less than optimum investigation results, based on the workplace incident statistics."

Competencies of an safety professional






Competencies include....

- 1. Understand risk assessment and control
- 2. Interact with parties, agencies, authorities
- 3. Leadership
- 4. Provide direction
- 5. Communication skills (written, oral & aural)
- 6. Knowledge of regulations/industry practices
- 7. Conflict resolution, mediation approaches


