What is Quality Assurance?

Quality assurance (commonly referred to as QA) is a set of principles, processes, and protocols a company sets in order to ensure that the quality of the products and services they offer are consistently high and are compliant with organizational and regulatory standards.



Once the model for high quality has been set, QA steps in to serve as a template to guide workers in meeting quality objectives for each individual product and for each instance a service is rendered.

We all have our own ideas on what quality is supposed to be. But in the context of the products and services we pay for, the work we do, and the life we live, we all want and strive for good quality.



DID YOU KNOW? Energy Efficiency

We're fortunate to be living in an era dominated by technology and innovation. Smart technology, transportation efficiencies and useful apps are everywhere, making it easier for all of us to live more efficiently. So, with all of this amazing innovation, I often wonder why so many people still aren't living greener.

If all of us made just one eco-friendly change, we would significantly impact the Earth, our communities and our energy bills. In case some of you are willing to make small changes but don't know what to do to be energy-efficient, below are some things you can do to be greener at home.

· Lower Your Thermostat - Adopt the habit of lowering the temperature on your thermostat while away from home or at night when you're sleeping. Dropping the temp by just three to five degrees may reduce your monthly utility bill and use less energy.

. Start a Compost Pile - You don't need a ton of space in your backyard to start a compost pile. Compost is the result of organic waste that's kept in a pile or container that decomposes over time. Your fruit and vegetable waste not only becomes valuable fertilizer for your lawn or garden, but it reduces the amount of trash you produce on a daily basis

. Seal All Windows - Go the extra mile by sealing the air leaks in and around the windows in your home. If your windows are drafty, consider adding weatherstripping around the frames.

- · Limit Space Heater Use Although electric and gas space heaters keep your feet nice and toasty in cooler weather, they aren't the most efficient way to heat your home. Many space heaters use 1,500 watts of energy to run and are considered to be a costly way to drain your energy bill. Be sure the model of your space heater is energy-efficient; consider layering clothing or investing in blankets instead of cranking up your thermostat.
- · Turn Off Unnecessary Water Be conscious of running water while brushing your teeth or shaving. Also, bathing typically uses 75 gallons of water compared to a shower that uses about 17.2 gallons on average. You also should avoid running half-loads of laundry in your washer. A full load means more clothes get washed at once, which in turn conserves water (and money).
- Replace Incandescent Bulbs LED bulbs offer longer lasting light and are more energy-efficient than your old incandescent bulbs. Since the average home uses 40 bulbs, switching over to greener bulbs is a great way to save on your electrical bill.
- · Unplug Unused Chargers Cell phone and battery chargers that are plugged in but not in use are often referred to as energy vampires. According to Energy.gov, the average charger consumes 0.26 watts of energy when not in use and 2.24 watts when connected to your phone. Alone, one charger won't

"I am a huge supporter of the Don't Walk By approach that is used at Dexterra. I firmly believe you can walk into any room and find at least one issue that would need to be corrected; you then have two choices – keep walking or fix it (if you can, otherwise, report to your supervisor). The first option could lead to an injury, while the second will prevent that injury and ensure your coworkers go home safely at night. Not only does the DWB approach take note of issues, it also allows us to recognize employees, who contribute to make a difference and who live by the HSEQ credo; this also is easy to find when you pay attention to your co-workers.

The need for paper copies of the DWB has been eliminated/reduced and we are able to record everything digitally in an app. I have always been an advocate for and will continue to encourage all employees to use the DWB approach.*

"In the last 6 months, we have picked up the pace and the entire team is really engaged in the Don't Walk By, Take Action Nowapproach and it's been keeping the conversation around health, safety, environment and quality open. There is also a lot more sharing of the Don't Walk By observations (DWBs). We now take five DWBs a week and send out an email to every employee in Energy Services to reinforce the observations that are coming up often.

Employees think that people leaders aren't looking at them, so they started to wonder what's the point in reporting

DWBs? Now that they know we're looking and taking action, it inspires them to participate more and, this goes beyond the workplace."
